

Wednesday through Friday, 11:30AM - 4:30PM, and 90 minutes prior to all performances.

Advanced reservations are recommended and can be made online at **www.tippingpointtheatre.com**, or by calling our Ticket Office at **248.347.0003**. Online sales are not eligible for any discounts. Tickets may be purchased with cash, check or credit card in person at the Ticket Office.

Opening Night

Join us for the official opening of a production. Enjoy hors d'oeuvres and drinks at the theatre.

Cancelation and Return Policy

Ticket sales are final. All tickets are exchangeable up until the day of the performance based on availability. Not all productions may appeal to all patrons or are appropriate for all ages, therefore, patrons will be responsible for making informed purchasing decisions. No refunds or exchanges will be issued based on a production's content.

Group Reservations and Discounts

Ticket Pricing

Preview performances - \$32; Opening night - \$55; All other performances - \$39.

Discounts

Senior (age 62+) and Military - \$2 off regular ticket price; Students (with valid ID) - \$20/ticket. Discounts not applicable for preview, opening night, or special event performances.

Seating

Reserved seating begins 30 minutes before the show. Due to the intimate nature of our space, late seating is difficult and disruptive to our audience and actors alike. Please plan on arriving at least 15 minutes prior to curtain. Late seating will be at the discretion of our house manager. There will be no late seating past 15 minutes into a performance. If your season pass tickets are not picked up 10 minutes prior to show time, we reserve the right to sell your seat.

Accessibility

All performances are accessible; please mention special accommodations when making reservations.

No Call, No Show Policy

All unclaimed ticket reservations will not be refunded and cannot be exchanged for another performance once the ticketed performance begins. TPT reserves the right to sell unclaimed seats at performance times.
